

The YMCA Rise School of Dallas is an early childhood education program with three major goals: to provide children with a blend of intervention and therapy services within the context of a developmentally appropriate curriculum; to provide family centered services designed to meet the needs of all children and families; and to prepare children for their next learning environment. The Rise School is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), a prestigious recognition achieved by only 7% of early childhood programs nationwide. The Rise School is the only NAEYC school in Dallas specializing in children with special needs.

- Serving children with and without developmental delays, ages 6 months (starting September 1, 2016) until 6 years
- Integration of children having developmental delays with peers who do not; 30% are children without delays.
- 3-4:1 child/instructor ratio with classes up to 10 children.
- Master's level teachers.
- Assessment, Evaluation, Programming System (AEPS) Curriculum with developmental assessments for all children.
- Multidisciplinary evaluations and development of an Individualized Intervention Plan for children with developmental delays.
- Occupational, physical, speech and music therapy, provided within the context of the educational environment using an integrative approach with therapy goals implemented collaboratively by the therapists and teaching staff.
- Specially designed instruction, curricular adaptations and technology are embedded in all class activities.
- Preparation for transition to inclusive educational settings, such as a traditional kindergarten class.
- Full year services with scheduled breaks.
- Classes are in session 8:00-2:30 Monday through Friday.
- Tuition is \$1,100 per month. Siblings receive a 30% discount. Tuition is based on the full year program expenses with 12 equal monthly installments. Financial aid is offered, when funds are available, for those who qualify with assistance ranging from 20% up to 80% of the regular tuition cost based on a family's gross income and the number in the household.
